### 223 respondents

- 72% 26 yrs+

- 11% of our total responses
- 38% responded to using vaping products in the last 30 days
- 65% responded vaping as a high risk
- 4% responded vaping as no risk
- 67% responded as having a high level of knowledge of the risks of vaping
- 8% responded as having no knowledge of the risks of vaping

### 19 Middle School age respondents (11-13yrs)

- 9% of our total responses
- 11% responded to using vaping products in the last 30 days
- 79% responded vaping as a high risk
- 5% responded vaping as no risk
- · 42% responded as having a high level of knowledge of the risks of vaping
- 5% responded as having no knowledge of the risks of vaping

### 15 young adult respondents (19-25yrs)

- 7% of our total responses
- 27% responded to using vaping products in the last 30 days
- 60% responded vaping as a high risk
- 13% responded vaping as no risk
- 53% responded as having a high level of knowledge of the risks of vaping






# Q2 What is your gender?



# Q4 How much do you think people risk harming themselves if they vape/use e-cigarettes regularly?





# Q5 Overall what would you consider your level of awareness of the health risks or harm associated with vaping/e-cigarette use to be?






